- Be an ordained minister with at least a masters degree in Christian theology.

- Be fully supported by a Reformed or Presbyterian sending church or denomination that subscribes to the Three Forms of Unity or the Westminster Standards.
- Feel called by God to serve at Mukhanyo for the coming of Christ's kingdom.
- Be willing to mentor students and assist in rural and/or urban church ministry.
- Demonstrate excellent interpersonal, conflict resolution, and communication skills with the ability to provide godly mentoring within a multicultural institution.
